You can check in on Sunday, July 10, between 7:00 and 9:00 am. All goats **MUST** be on the grounds by 9:00 AM Sunday, July 10, 2011. Goats must be penned. Dismissal will be at the conclusion of the show, or 5 pm, whichever is later.

Only goats registered through ADGA, AGS, or CGA will be permitted to enter. The following documents are required and must be presented to the show secretary before the start of the show: for animals six months of age or older, a registration or recordation certificate; for animals under six months of age, a registration or recordation certificate or stamped duplicate application showing the date received by the office. All animals **MUST** be legibly tattooed.

All rules of the N.Y. Dept. of Agriculture and Markets are in effect. An official Health Certificate is required. All animals will be checked. Out-of-state exhibitors must have proper interstate health papers. No exceptions. Rabies vaccination recommended, but not required.

Goats with horns will not be permitted to enter. There will be no pre-show milk-out. Over-distended udders are subject to discrimination. All goats are entered at the sole risk of the owners. Judge's decision is final.

ALL ANIMALS MUST BE HEALTHY, *No visible signs of abscesses or other contagious diseases (pinkeye, soremouth, ringworm, etc.) will be allowed. In case of a discrepancy, or for rules not adequately covered, the superintendent's decision will be final.*

No additions or changes after 9:30 am Sunday, July 10, 2011. Deletions only.
Substitutions can be made for no extra fee.

Pens are 5' by 6'; exhibitors must bring their own bedding. Straw or shavings acceptable. No charge for pens. Tack pens will be available, space permitting. Exhibitor is responsible for cleaning pens before departure.

All animals are to be penned, or on a leash. No loose animals, please. This is for everyone's safety and enjoyment of the fair.

Ribbons will be awarded in all classes, with placings 1 - 5 for the regular classes and rosettes for the championship classes. Premiums for placings 1 through 3 will be \$10, \$6, and \$4 in the regular classes. No premiums in the championship classes.

This Jr/Sr Doe show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association for the following breeds: Alpine, Lamancha, Nubian, Oberhasli, Recorded Grade, Saanen, and Toggenburg. The Junior and Senior shows are not separately sanctioned. ADGA rules shall govern.

Fees: Exhibitor fee is \$10.00 per exhibitor. Entry fees are \$5.00 per class. No fee for showmanship classes. Acceptable forms of payment are money order or check made out to **Cayuga County Ag Society**.

NOTE: We are adhering to USDA regulations that no animal under one month of age will be allowed to show, or be at the show. No doe within one month of kidding is to be at the show. This will be enforced.

Exhibitors' vehicles are permitted on the grounds for loading and unloading animals only.

Awards:

Premiums for all regular classes, except showmanship, for places 1 through 3 are \$10.00, \$6.00, and \$4.00.

Ribbons will be awarded for placings 1 through 5.

Grand champion and reserve grand champion.....ADGA rosette
Best of breed.....ADGA rosette
Best Doe in Show.....plaque

Class Schedule-Open Dairy Goat Show

SHOWMANSHIP (no entry fee)

- Class 1 - Novice showmanship, ages 8 & under, or under 13 and never shown
- Class 2 - Junior showmanship, ages 9 to 13
- Class 3 - Senior showmanship, ages 14 to 18
- Class 4 - Adult showmanship, 19 years and over

BREED CLASSES (Base date for calculating age is July 10, 2011)

Junior does (never milked)

- Class 5 - Under 4 months
- Class 6 - 4 months to under 8 months
- Class 7 - 8 months to under 15 months
- Class 8 - 15 months to under 24 months
- Class 9 - *Junior Champion and Reserve Champion*
