## OPEN MEAT GOAT SHOW

Saturday, July 9, 2011

**Entries must be postmarked by June 30, 2011**

Check in is on Friday, July 8 between 10:00 am and 10:00 pm, or Saturday morning, July 9, between 7:00 and 8:30 am.

All goats MUST be on the grounds by 8:00 AM Saturday, July 9, 2011 and must be penned. All goats MUST be scrapie ear tagged, or tattooed with appropriate registration identification, and accompanied by a current health certificate. No exceptions. Rabies vaccination recommended but not required.

ALL ANIMALS MUST BE HEALTHY, *No visible signs of abscesses or other contagious diseases (pinkeye, soremouth, ringworm, etc.) will be allowed. In case of a discrepancy, or for rules not adequately covered, the show committee decision will be final.*

**No additions or changes after 8:30 am Saturday, July 9, 2011; deletions only.**  
**Substitutions can be made for no extra fee prior to 8:30 on Saturday.**

Entries in meat and wether classes will be weighed in the show ring area starting at 8:00 am on Saturday. All entries in classes 1 and 2 must be weighed if entries warrant splitting the classes.

Pens are 5' by 6' and exhibitors must bring their own bedding. Straw or shavings acceptable. No charge for pens; tack pens will be available, space permitting. Exhibitor is responsible for cleaning pens before departure.  
*All animals are to be penned, or on a lead. No loose animals, please. This is for everyone's safety and enjoyment of the fair.*

Ribbons will be awarded in all classes, with placings 1 - 5 for the regular classes and rosettes for the championship classes. Premiums for placings 1 through 3 are \$10.00, \$6.00, and \$4.00 in the regular classes. No premiums in the championship classes.

***NOTE: We are adhering to USDA regulations that no animal under one month of age will be allowed to show, or be at the show. No doe within one month of kidding is to be at the show. This will be enforced.***

Exhibitors' vehicles are permitted on the grounds for loading and unloading animals only.

# Class Schedule

## **MEAT CLASSES (cannot enter Breeding Stock Classes)** **Weights to be determined at show for classes 1 and 2**

**Class 1** - Open Meat animal, any sex; class will split into weight groups if entries warrant

**Class 2** - Market wethers - owned or leased and shown by a youth; class will be split into weight groups if entries warrant

**Class 3** - *Champion & Reserve Champion meat animal*

## **YOUTH CLASSES**

**Class 4** – Senior youth showmanship, 12 years to under 19 years as of January 1, 2011 youth must have owned, raised, leased, or trained the goat

**Class 5** - Junior youth showmanship, under 12 years of age; youth must have owned, raised, leased or trained the goat

## **BREEDING STOCK CLASSES (cannot enter Meat Classes)**

**Class 6** - Buck kids, 1 - 12 months

- Class 30** - *Champion and Reserve Champion % / unreg yearling doe*
- Class 31** - Two year old does, 24 - 30 mo
- Class 32** - Two year old does, 30 - 36 mo
- Class 33** - Aged does, 3 years & over
- Class 34** - *Champion and Reserve Champion % / unreg senior doe*
- Class 35**- *Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion % / unreg doe overall*

- Class 41** - *Champion and Reserve Champion fullblood junior doe*
- Class 42** – Yearling does, 12 - 18 mo
- Class 43** - Yearling does, 18 - 24 mo
- Class 44** - *Champion and Reserve Champion fullblood yearling Doe*
- Class 45** - Two year old does, 24 - 30 mo
- Class 46** - Two year old does, 30 - 36 mo
- Class 47** – Aged does, 3 years & over
- Class 48** - *Champion and Reserve Champion fullblood senior doe*
- Class 49**- *Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Doe, overall*
- Class 50** - ***Best of Show, chosen from champion meat animal, grand champion buck, grand champion percentage/unregistered doe, & grand champion fullblood/purebred doe***
- Class 51**- Produce of dam; two goats, any sex, from the same dam; entries to have been shown in a previous class
- Class 52**- Get of sire; three goats, any sex, from the same sire; entries to have been shown in a previous class
